We don't take this responsibility lightly. Our commitment to you is to provide your child with a memorable, safe, and life-changing camp experience.

## About the camp

Our goal is to effectively communicate the good news of Jesus Christ to every camper who attends. We choose our summer staff on the basis of their personal commitment to Jesus Christ, their maturity, character, and love for children and youth. Each staff member is required to provide a criminal record check. These youth and young adults make superb role models for kids. Senior staff go through an intensive training program and are certified in St John's Ambulance First Aid before summer camp begins. The majority of these staff members serve for the entire summer.

We provide a safe and caring environment where your child can experience God's love. Health and safety are priorities. A nurse is on staff at all camps, and a hospital is a short distance away. A certified lifeguard is on duty whenever swimming activities are open. Personal safety and proper use of equipment is emphasized at all times.

## Camp Sponsorships

It is our desire that every child have the opportunity to attend camp. A fund is available through donations from individuals and churches. If financial assistance is needed, simply register your child by paying the \$40.00 deposit and indicate on the registration form that you are requesting a sponsorship. An application form will be sent to you to complete and return. We will notify you with the amount you are approved for.

## Family Discounts

Discounts are available for children of an immediate family. The third child receives a \$25.00 discount, and the fourth and following children receives \$50.00 off the registration fee. The discount applies to the cost of camp only and **applications must be received on the same day** to qualify so payment can be adjusted accordingly. Children may only attend one camp each (not including weekend parent/child camps).

The program is offered in July and then again in August. Since it is only a commitment of half the summer you will still have time for mission trips, family vacations or if you attend the July session then you could work at SABC for August!
