TELEPHONE INFORMATION

SABC has very limited cell phone coverage. The best signal can be found on the dining room in the northeast corner. In case of an emergency a phone is located at the front desk. Please radio the host if there is an emergency!

WIRELESS INTERNET

Wireless internet is available throughout our Facility and the password is: Lodge2011

SUITE KEY

If you get locked out of your room there is a suite key on the front desk. Please return it immediately after use.

THERMOSTAT SETTINGS

The Travers Lodge suites have individual heating and cooling units controlled by the remote on the wall in your room. Point the remote at the unit and choose your temperature! Check with your host if you need assistance.

ALCOHOL/CANNABIS

SABC is an alcohol and cannabis free facility.

CURFEW

Camp wide quiet time is 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.

MEALS

Our meal times will be 8:30am, 12:00pm and 5:30pm unless otherwise indicated by your retreat coordinator. Meals are served in the dining hall, buffet style. Guests will be required to clear and scrape dishes and wipe their table. If you have a special diet please take a moment to touch base with our cook in the kitchen at your earliest convenience.

HOUSING

Guests are required to supply their own bedding and personal items. Suites are equipped with a bathmat, hand towel and hand soap. Please do not move beds or mattresses. Guests are required to remove wet or muddy footwear at the entrance—we recommend guests bring indoor shoes.

RADIO ETIQUETTE

There will be a 2 way radio on the front desk for groups to contact their host. Radios are to be used for emergencies and to communicate small amounts of information.

Use these steps:

- 1) Initiate contact— “Group coordinator to host”
- 2) Wait for response or try again if no response
- 3) Communicate information clearly and with as few words as possible.
- 4) Wait for response and acknowledge.
- 5) Sign off

FIREPLACES

Please ask for a staff member to light it for you.

SMOKING

Please check with your host and they will point out the designated smoking area.

FIRE/EMERGENCY PROTOCOL

In the event of a fire please locate the nearest exit and calmly evacuate the building. Make your way immediately to the field beside the parking lot and await further instructions. Please give your host a complete list of your group and room assignments in advance or upon arrival so all guests can be accounted for in the event of an emergency.

PROPERTY BOUNDARIES

North – Be very careful of the steep banks by the lake

East – Beach road

South – Fence Line

West – Top of the Cross Hill

Please stay out of camp houses, camp vehicles, and off roofs.

PETS

No pets are allowed on the grounds with the exception of guide dogs. Note the cats you see on the property are mousers, belong to a camp family and are not allowed in any buildings including cabins.

UPON DEPARTURE

Lodge: Please place your bathroom garbage bag and bathmat (if used) in the hall outside of your room. Windows should be closed and lights turned off.

Cabins: Please sweep out your cabins and dispose of garbage in the main garbage bin in the cabin circle. Make sure lights are off in the cabins and windows are shut and locked.

AMENITIES

GYMNASIUM

Our gym is located on the lower level of the Lodge at Travers. Please feel free to use it and the equipment provided in the north equipment room. Please put all balls and equipment away after use. No food or drink is allowed in the gym.

GAMES AREA

You will find a ping pong table, foosball table, pool table, and air hockey table in our games area. We also have a wide variety of table games for your enjoyment.

SEASONAL ACTIVITIES

From May until September we offer a variety of paid programming (see the programming request form or check with your rental coordinator for more information). This includes complementary use of our beach and boathouse. The wearing of life jackets during use of canoes and kayaks is mandatory. Any child under 16 must be supervised by an attentive adult.


WALKING AROUND OUR SITE

Please respect the boundaries. Be aware of signage that might be warning of programming in progress such as archery. Also be conscientious and respectful of other groups on the property.


COFFEE, TEA & HOT CHOCOLATE


LOWER LEVEL
