### Position Description

- The W.A.S.H. Crew are vital to the day to day operation of SABC. All W.A.S.H. Crew will be required to be flexible, hardworking, and have a desire to do their daily assignments with excellence. Staff will be a part of a community that will work hard to love the campers and other staff, seek after Christ, and share the clear Gospel message. This includes:
  - Daily cleaning tasks as assigned by the WASH Director (as well as jobs that come up without notice) and in accordance with Alberta Environmental Health and Safety standards. Some examples of tasks may include:
    - Sanitizing high touch surfaces
    - Cleaning bathrooms
    - Sweeping and mopping floors
    - Washing windows
    - Vacuuming
  - Character - Hold oneself to a high standard of integrity in all areas of life (having a good reputation in the church and community, having a good personal work ethic, having sound Christian character, and having the respect of their own family). Exemplify a healthy Bible study and prayer life. Having a heart for seeing people grow spiritually, deepening their walk with Christ.
  - Attend daily staff chapels.
  - Participate in wide games as needed by the Program Director.
  - Wholeheartedly participate in the camp program by attending chapels as available.
  - Be available and assist other staff members in various aspects of camp operations.
  - Participate fully in community life in a Christ honoring manner.
  - Ensure living quarters inside the lodge are kept clean and orderly.
  - Be familiar and ready to adhere to SABC's Plan to Protect, REDI, and emergency policies.
  - Hold the care of other team members as a high value - supporting and encouraging other staff, refraining from gossip, comparison or harmful talk.
  - Be able to produce a Criminal Record Check.
  - Chemistry - Able to submit to the authority of God, take direction from the SABC leadership, and to work as a team player with staff and volunteers.
  - Must endorse and support the SABC Statement of Belief, Mission Statement, and Staff Code of Conduct
